

## Ways to Use This Book

These ninety daily devotionals are simple and yet powerful. Each one has flowed from the trenches of real life and is made up of a **Scripture**, a **Prayer**, and an **Encouragement**. Use this book for:

**PERSONAL DEVOTIONS**—As a man, you may insert your name into the prayers, and use this in your daily time with God to experience the prayer as prayed for yourself. The encouragements will lift your heart as you feel them spoken into your own life.

**PRAYER FOR HUSBANDS, FATHERS, SONS**—Pray for a significant man in your life (husband, father, son, fiancé, grandfather, friend). Insert his name into the prayer, and pray daily healing into his life. Then, as God directs, use the scriptures and encouragements as a tool to help you speak truth and encouragement into his life.
